Current
Status

Modified Traditional Schedule: Brick and Mortar

- 4 days of in-school instruction (Mon-Thurs.)
With a 2 ½ -hour early dismissal
- 1 day of blended learning (at home) Friday
- Daily Deep cleaning and disinfecting
- Face coverings required when social distancing cannot occur
- Students have learning activities to complete at home to support daily classroom instruction
- Parent/Guardian meetings occur virtually
- Essential visitors only (food vendors, postal and package delivery personnel, emergency personnel). Essential visitors screened prior to entrance and face coverings required when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Extracurricular and co-curricular activities follow WVSSAC guidance
- School bus transportation: assigned seats and face coverings required
- Breakfast and lunch provided on site

Distance Learning

- 5 days per week
- At-home instruction
- Students have instruction delivered by regular classroom teacher(s).
- Daily learning activities and assignments completed with support from parents
- Braxton County Schools curriculum
- Same grading scale as brick and mortar students
- Student/Parent/Guardian meetings occur virtually
- Meals available for parent pick up
- Students may opt back into school at the end of a grading period.

Full Remote Learning - Occurs only if a school(s) or the district is required to close at the order of the Governor or the Braxton County Health Department

- 5 days per week
- No in-school instruction
- Instruction delivered remotely by student's assigned teacher(s)
- Teacher availability set with office hours
- Student participation required daily
- Same grading scale
- Assignments with due dates
- School facilities open only to school personnel
- Parent/Guardian meetings occur virtually
- No extracurricular or co-curricular activities
- Meals available for parent pick up

Traditional Schedule

- 5 days per week
- In-school instruction
- Daily cleaning and disinfecting
- Visitors permitted with screening prior to entrance. Face coverings required when social distancing cannot be maintained
- Parent/guardian meeting may occur in person
- Extracurricular and co-curricular activities follow WVSSAC guidance
- School bus transportation: assigned seats and face coverings required
- Breakfast and lunch provided on site

West Virginia Virtual School

- Students must be enrolled in Braxton County Schools
- Instruction through full-time enrollment in West Virginia Virtual School
- Must have reliable access to a high-speed internet connection away from school
- Teacher and curriculum provided by WVVS
- Grades assigned by the WVVS teacher(s)
- Instruction accessible and available 24 hours
- Same grading scale as Braxton County Schools
- Students are assigned a Braxton County teacher as a facilitator to monitor progress. Student required to meet virtually with facilitator once per week
- Follows calendar of Braxton County Schools
- Meals available for parent pick up
