All enrolled student have received a laptop in order to access the Internet, digital course materials, and digital textbooks.

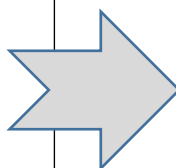
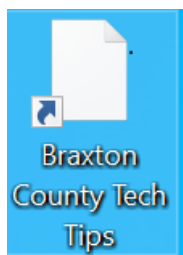


Fast Facts for Parents

- ✓ 1 to 1 is not just a COVID initiative, it is a technology initiative to support implementation of learning standards and student achievement.
- ✓ Due to safety concerns and the need to offer distance learning and virtual learning opportunities, the Braxton County Board (BCBOE) of Education and county staff prioritized the purchase of laptops for each student as an immediate need.
- ✓ Laptops for distant learners (DL) were handed out first.
- ✓ Resources to support DL and brick and mortar (B&M) students may be located on the BCS webpage.
- ✓ BCS is using Microsoft Teams as our learning platform.
- ✓ The use of Microsoft Teams with DL and B&M students provides a seamless transition between instruction with DL and B&M students. It also allows BCS to use local teachers for all coursework.
- ✓ Parent, student and teachers resource are located as an icon on the desktop of each laptop.

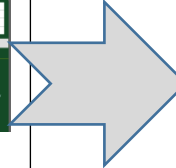
